THE PROGRAMME

The Graduate Diploma in Theology is a 120 credit, Level 7, NZQA registered qualification.

How can I study for the GradDip?

You can study either part-time or full-time.

Papers are offered face-to-face at the Auckland campus and also online.

Entry Requirement

A bachelor's degree in any subject.

Recognition of Prior Learning

If you have completed other papers with CTC or another theological provider, you may qualify for recognition of prior learning.
