The Process of enrolling as a student of the University of Notre Dame Australia (UNDA)

Why?

Because the papers that CTC lectures belong to the University of Notre Dame, Australia, as part of their Bachelor of Divinity. Enrolling with us implies enrolling with them.

UNDA provide the online learning environment – "the Blackboard" – where materials are provided by your lecturers, where you hand up your assignments and where you see your marks.

Applying:

According to their website

Our admissions process comprises four easy steps:

- 1. **Apply** direct or via an education agent
- 2. **Receive your offer** successful applicants receive an offer via email
- 3. **Accept -** your offer and make fee payment
- 4. **Enrol** receive your eCoE and apply for your student visa (if applicable), and enrol at Notre Dame

<u>Web browsers</u> For an optimum user experience, please use either Chrome or Firefox (latest versions). Please also ensure to have JavaScript enabled in your browser.
Email account. Please use your primary personal email address to create your account. It will be the email address Notre Dame will use to correspond with you about your application. If you are a current Year 12 student do not use your school email address as you will likely lose access lafer in the year and miss emails from us.
Email set-up Please ensure '@nd.edu.au' is added to your safe senders list and that you check your junk/spam folders regularly. Do not use your work email address if it is behind a firewall.
<u>Document size and compatible file formats.</u> Documents uploaded to the application must be no bigger than 2MB each. Acceptable file formats are: pdf, doc, docx, PNG and jpeg.


You will need your mobile phone, because the first step involves a One Time Password (OTP) being sent to your phone. Make sure you put the "+64" on the start of your phone number (and drop the leading zero).

It is a long and complicated form, they want proof of identity (Certified copy of Passport) and copies of any academic transcripts.


As regards **programs**

- Both domestic and international applicants must select **Undergraduate** (next to Applicant Type) in order to select **B.Divinity** as their program;
- International applicants seeking to undertake non-award study (i.e. the Graduate Diploma in Theology) must select Academic Pathway Program (next to Applicant Type) in order to select the appropriate 'not-for-degree' program (being NFD (UG) – Phil and Theology);
- <u>All</u> applicants should select **On Campus** as their Study Location.

If you are doing the CTC Graduate Diploma in Theology



Other hints for the form:

- You're an INTERNATIONAL
- NO, you don't have an AUSTRALIAN student visa put "N/A" in any Visa question
- Undergraduate
- Semester 1 (Feb) is Study Period 1, Semester 2 (July) is Study Period 2
- Your study location is "On Campus" even if you are studying by distance
- We are the "CIS New Zealand Campus"
- Mode either **Full-Time** (4 papers) or **Part-time**.

If you successfully submit the form, you get this:

Once your acceptance has been processed, you will receive an SMS and email from us inviting you to set up your Notre Dame student profile and take the next steps to enrol. Please note that this may take several days to process during peak admission periods.

You may get a follow-up from Admissions about your documents or about documents you did not supply. Days pass ... and then you receive an OFFER OF PLACE

Step 2: Receive your offer

Step 3: Accept your offer

This is the easiest of the steps – just **click** on that button.

Do click the button to accept your offer of place, DO NOT pay your fees directly to them. CTC collects the NZ fees and pays for all of you in a single transaction.

By this point you should have your Student ID (the long and important number) and have established a password.

Step 4: Enrol


